1. Provide a location

Park, church, backyard, or community center! Wherever children can gather, we can do a club. A great location would have enough room to play some active games and sit down to listen to the club time teaching. Think of the places where kids spend their time during the summer; community centers, daycares, parks and summer school. These are the places your church will want to minister through the *5-Day Club* along with individual homes.

2. Invite the children

We will print off invitations for you to pass out to the children in the neighborhood. The *5-Day Club* meets once a day for five days. Churches have had great success with choosing three locations in nearby neighborhoods to have a week of *5-Day Club*. On the last day of the week they have an optional rally or special event at their church.

Ask if there is a Good News Club in your neighborhood and invite the children who usually attend.

3. Volunteers to interact with the kids

Building a stronger connection between the children and your church body (optional, but strongly recommended). This helps bring the children and their families to the church.

4. Snack

Make or buy a snack for each day. There are theme snacks recommended, but it is your choice! If this is not a possibility for you, we can bring some pre-packaged snacks for the kids.
